

Directions to workshop site:

The address is 675 N. Glenville Dr. #165, Richardson, TX (do not send entry forms to this address). Take US Hwy 75 (Central Expressway) to Arapahoe Road in Richardson, East to Glenville Drive, South about 1000' to the workshop site.

Note that the Barn Hunt training area is behind (West of) the main WAGD facility - see the satellite photo below for the precise location.



Hotels and Other Accommodations

Working slot entrants must also submit course designs to Mark by email before October 10th (one complete single trial, Novice through Master with Crazy 8s between Open and Senior). A diagram of the rings will be provided in adequate time for the design exercise.

A copy of the Barn Hunt rule book will be provided on a USB stick to each participant, as well as some note-taking material. Please bring anything you think you may need beyond this. (Bring a chair - the facility may or may not provide adequate chairs.)

A light breakfast and lunch, and snacks and refreshments, will be provided to all participants on both days. There is also fast food available a short drive away.
